UPDATE ON THE FORMING OF THE NEW PARISH OF WEYBRIDGE

On 2nd January 2024 Bishop Richard issued a new Pastoral Plan for the Diocese of Arundel & Brighton: The Word Who is Life: The Call to Mission. Since then, we have had a few opportunities to find out more about his intention to put in place some new measures to enhance our pastoral work within the parishes and deaneries. There is a special webinar available on the diocesan website which sets the parameter for the structures of the new pastoral centres. I took part in the training for the moderators where some of the potential implications were outlined and discussed. This is an early stage of the process and no conclusions have been made. The next meeting of the local clergy and the diocesan representatives will take place at the end of June, and it will mark "a beginning of a journey" for our deanery rather than a launch of the new structure. I will update you along the way and please keep Canon Kieron O'Brien, Deacon Nick St. John, local clergy, lay leadership teams and all those involved in your prayers. In addition to the conversations over the new Pastoral Plan, the Vision Team suggested creating a new Parish Pastoral Committee which will coordinate the pastoral work in the parish and communicate with the new pastoral centre in the deanery. We are still working on the details and will give you some more information in the coming weeks.
