Dear Parishioners

In this week's gospel reading (John 15: 9-17), Jesus delivers one of his most famous commandments: 'Love one another, as I have loved you'. That's the sort of line that would likely get Him millions of 'Likes' on his social media account today! So, it's a clear instruction to those who claim to follow Him - and, as one of those people, that includes me. But do I really love others in the selfless and sacrificial way Jesus loved (and loves) me? Probably not - certainly not often enough. The good news is that Jesus is ready to help us with those outreach efforts - when we do get around to creating that space and the focus on others, He'll be there to guide us. I hope that, despite the truly challenging times the world and many of us personally find ourselves to be in, you're able to draw comfort from that knowledge.
