

Hardship can fall on anyone at any time. Oasis, based in Cobham, provides vital support to vulnerable families and children in Elmbridge and surrounding areas. Every year they need to raise £300,000.

They support up to 100 families a week in need at their foodbank centre. On 17th April, as well as their usual foodbank supplies, they will also be providing families and children with fresh food. Some of the children in our Parish will be visiting Oasis on the 17th to give the Easter baskets they have made to the children Oasis support.

For the next 4 weeks we will be asking Parishioners to donate to the Foodbank collection - please see the baskets in the Church porch/nartex. Their requirements are for food, cleaning materials and toiletries for both adults and children.

We would also value any cash donations to help Oasis buy fresh food for the 17th. If you would like to do this please do so via either church office. Monies donated from Holy Name's Lenten Soup Lunches will also be going directly to OASIS to help purchase fresh food. We hope you will support this worthy cause.
