Dear parishioners

Habemus papam resounded on Thursday evening in Rome. Pope Leon XIV will hear and take personally the words from the Sunday liturgy about the care of the Good Shepherd. He is supposed to represent Jesus, the Good Shepherd here on earth and ensure all the sheep are safe and provided with spiritual nourishment.
