Newsletter 6th June, 2025 PENTECOST

This Sunday we celebrate Pentecost. We have seen the Holy Spirit at work in the Church over the last couple of months. We watched how the cardinals gathered in Rome to discern God's will and elect the new pope. During the conclave, they were "locked up" in the Sistine Chapel and thus separated from the noise of the world. This is the first clue for the people seeking the guidance of the Holy Spirit. You can hear his gentle voice more clearly when you pray and avoid the distractions of all sorts. I can not think of a better way of doing so than participating in the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The upcoming feast of Corpus Christi is yet another opportunity to honour the Blessed Sacrament and benefit from Jesus' presence in the Eucharist. There is another less spectacular way of spotting the gentle breeze of the Holy Spirit moving the hearts of the faithful. The Holy Spirit is given to us for our sanctification. That is why we welcome the good news about the canonization of Pier Giorgio Frassati, which is going to take place in Rome on 5th August. This young Catholic activist, mountaineer, and member of St Vincent the Paul Society worked for the poor in Turin, Italy and exhibited the gifts of the Holy Spirit: great love for the needy and desire to be close to Jesus. We pray for all the faithful and the young people in particular that we get inspired by the lives of the saints and let the Holy Spirit work within us, for the sanctification of our souls and the benefit of others. **Fr Sebastian**
