HOLY NAME - VOLUNTEERING ACTION PLAN

In recent months a number of discussions have taken place regarding Parishioner volunteering at Holy Name. Those discussions have happened within the Parish Pastoral Committee (PPC), within the Holy Name leadership group, individually between myself and a number of Parishioners, and in a volunteers open-forum meeting held on June 18th in the Parish Rooms. It's clear from all of these discussions that we need to address the challenge we face today, and this Volunteering Action Plan - which is reflective of much of the input received from our current volunteers in those various discussions - is our agreed way forward.

1. Background - our volunteering challenge

* Holy Name currently has almost 30 individual ministries (see list below), with an average of 5 volunteers per ministry

* many Parishioners are today volunteering with multiple ministries

* some ministries are now joint with Our Lady of Lourdes, others are standalone Holy Name

* the demographic profile of the Holy Name volunteers shows an average age of 60+

* a number of our current volunteers have indicated that they intend to begin stepping-back from some/all of their activities, mainly for age or health reasons

* particular challenges exist with one or two key individuals who currently lead multiple ministries and/or are involved in almost every aspect of our church activity and maintenance

* the intended integration of Holy Name into the new Moderated Parish of Weybridge will necessitate an increased level of volunteering by the laity in the coming years

2. Plan - how we will address the challenge

* by grouping 5 of the existing ministries into 2 'clusters', as pilots, to pool our volunteer resources and create nominated go-to contact points (see list below)

* by holding meetings with the volunteers from those 5 ministries to agree how the clusters will work, and to then run with these pilots through to the end of 2025, at which point additional ministry clusters will be considered * by having a <u>new</u> volunteer 'Sign-Up September', with appeals being made at Masses, on the Parish website, on the Parish notice-boards, in the Parish newsletters, and at Parish meetings

* by introducing the approach of having one of the Mass Welcomers speak from the altar immediately before each Mass to share information about the Children's Liturgy, coffee after Mass, etc., and as a means of encouraging newer Parishioners to commit more time to supporting the church
