#### **MESSAGE FROM FR SEBASTIAN**

For those who did not hear the message read out at Mass last weekend, please see below:

Dear parishioners, friends from outside the parish, St Paul's School community and all of you who showed me so much heart and care. It's been a difficult time for me for the last few months in the hospital as at the critical point I was on the verge of sepsis. I was not fully aware what was going on with me but I felt that it was God's grace fortified

by your prayers that helped me to go through that dark time. I'd like to thank you for all the wonderful cards and messages. I wish I could respond to them individually, but you are very much in my heart.

Thank you for supporting my family as they also experienced the challenge of coming from afar, to the place they didn't quite know to look after me. Now I've been transferred to a place of recovery and made aware it's going to take time before I regain some strength through rehabilitation. I still need to be cautious though as I'm extremely vulnerable and prone to infections. Annie Condon, the diocesan clergy welfare assistance has made all the arrangements on behalf of bishop Richard. I dare to ask for your continuous prayers in this new stage of my life and I keep you all in my heart.
