

### A Lecture at St Erconwald's – The mysteries of the Rosary in History and in Art, 18<sup>th</sup> March 7pm

Join us for this interesting lecture on 18<sup>th</sup> March at 7pm given by Dr Adam Sammut, University of York. The rosary is one of the most popular devotions in all of Catholicism. A product of late medieval piety, it has inspired a Marian cult and the foundation of brotherhoods around the world, with Pope John Paul II adding the Luminous Mysteries to this tradition in 2002. This lecture examines the remaking of the rosary during the Counter-Reformation, and the role of brotherhoods and visual art in defining it from the grassroots.
